

**Minutes of the Annual General Meeting of Wargame Developments
held on 12th July 2026 at Cranfield Management Development Centre**

1. The Chair and Conference Organiser (Tim Gow) said that it had been a cracking weekend, and that the venue had been spot on. Members responded with an ovation. Judith Rawle was thanked for finding the new venue.
2. The Treasurer and Membership Secretary (Bob Cordery) reported that he had good news. Membership was well over 100 and there was no need to increase subscription rates for 2026/27. Assuming no great increase in postage costs he hoped that subscription rates could also be kept the same for 2027/28. WD was becoming stronger. COW 2026 had 60 bookings (cf 38 at Knuston) and had generated a small surplus. He predicted no increase in the cost for COW 2027, which would be held on whichever of the first two weekends in July avoided Silverstone (the dates of which had yet to be announced). Bookings would open in September, and not before.
3. The Editor of "The NUGGET" (Matthew Hartley) reported that nine issues had been produced in the year, he was grateful to members for writing things, particularly if they sent them to him early. He was pleased to be able to announce that there would be an additional "summer special" Nugget in August. Members were asked to keep writing and sending things in. Members responded with an ovation.
4. The Editor of the Colour Supplement (Chris Ager) indicated that if members would send him decent pictures he would get the colour supplement going.
5. Reports by the Display Team Organisers
 - a. Display Team North - John Armatys reported that Martin Rapier had shown the flag at the Society of Ancients Conference 2025 with "Alexander the Brief", which he also took, assisted by Tim Gow, Tim Carne and John Armatys, to The Other Partizan in October 2026. Mark Flannagan and John Armatys's "633 Squadron" saw its debut at Partizan in May 2026, where they were joined by Rob Hymer and Tim Gow, who recruited a new member. Martin Rapier, Mark Flannagan, Rob Hymer and John Armatys took the game to "Joy of Six" in June.

It was hoped that there would be enough volunteers to put on games at The Other Partizan in October 2026 and at Partizan in May 2027. Booking a stand Joy of Six 2027 depended on it not clashing with the date of COW.
 - b. Display Team South - Chris Ager reported that he had not been to any shows, and asked any members able to represent WD to talk to him.
 - c. Display Team West - John Curry reported that he been mentioning WD at conferences. He was thinking about having a stand at DSET.
6. John Bassett proposed that the new constitution (circulated with the agenda for the AGM) should be adopted from the end of the meeting. Seconded by Bob Cordery, the motion was carried unanimously.
